- Small, consistent groups of campers who are registered for one-week sessions.
- Daily health screening of children before camp.
- Frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizer.
- Outdoor activities prioritized.
- Open lines of communication with parents.

Registration / Payment:

After submitting your registration, an invoice for the weeks you expressed interest in will be emailed to you.

Your reservations are guaranteed for 48 hours. If we do not receive payment within 48 hours after invoice send, your spots will be released.

Once paid, you can retain a copy of your invoice as a receipt.

What to bring to camp:

- Filled Water Bottle – please label.
- Sunscreen (waterproof, 30 plus is recommended) – please label.
- Lunch with additional snacks for fuel throughout the day.
- Change of clothes – label clothes.
- Any necessary medication with instructions/dosage. You will be required to fill out a medical consent form for all medications.

Please make sure that your children are dropped-off and picked-up in a timely manner.

Camp drop-off starts at 8:00 AM, and camp ends promptly at 5:00 PM.
